Vaccination Policy

To prevent the spread of disease while your pet is in our care, cats must be current on Rabies, FVRCP and Feline Leukemia for outdoor cats. It is the responsibility of the client to provide proof of vaccination history for each animal boarding. The vaccinations must be administered by a Veterinarian. Animals whose shots are not up to date must be vaccinated by Alameda East Veterinary Hospital prior to admittance and at the owner's expense or they will not be allowed to board. To insure the protection of all the pets under our care, the following vaccinations must be up to date 5 days prior to boarding.

## Disclaimers and Additional Provisions

(1) Standard precautions will be used against the injury, escape, or death of this pet. The clinic and staff will not be held responsible for illnesses or injuries that occur, provided standard care and precautions have been followed as determined at the sole discretion of Animal Lodge. It is expressly agreed by Owner and Animal Lodge that Animal Lodge's liability shall in no event exceed the lesser of the current chattel value of a pet of the same species or the sum of \$200.00 (Two Hundred Dollars) per animal boarded.

(2) Owner understands and agrees that the Owner is solely responsible for any harm caused by Owner's pet(s) while attending Animal Lodge. Owner further understands and agrees that in admitting Owner's pet to Animal Lodge all health and behavior problems have been fully disclosed to the best of owner's knowledge. A \$10 / per day handling charge will be assessed for any aggressive animals.

(3) Owner fully understands that any health, behavior or injury problems that develop during their pet's stay at Animal Lodge will be handled and treated as deemed appropriate by the employees at Animal Lodge and Alameda East Veterinary Hospital and owner agrees to assume full financial responsibility for any and all expenses arising from or relating thereto, subject to the stipulations set forth in the Medical / Illness policy above. In no event shall Animal Lodge or Alameda East Veterinary Hospital be liable for illnesses that arise during Owner's pet's stay or after Owner's pet has left the facility.

(4) Owner understands and agrees to the charges for boarding at Animal Lodge. Drop off and pick times for animals boarding at Animal Lodge are as follows: 7am-10am and 4pm-7pm. A late fee of \$5.00 will be assessed for drop offs and pickups between 5am and 9pm outside of the scheduled drop off times. Late pickups must be prearranged through the boarding facility. No drop offs or pick-ups will be allowed between the hours of 9pm and 5am.

(5) All charges incurred by the Owner under this agreement shall be due and payable in full upon pick up of the pet. Owner agrees that the pet shall not leave Animal Lodge until such time as all charges incurred by the Owner have been paid in full to Animal Lodge. In addition, Animal Lodge is hereby granted by Owner a lien on the pet for any and all unpaid charges resulting from boarding pet at Animal Lodge. Owner hereby agrees that in the event that all charges incurred under this contract are not paid when due, Animal Lodge may exercise its lien rights upon ten days written notice sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, to Owner at the address shown on this contract. Animal Lodge may dispose of pet for any and all unpaid charges, at public or private sale or by turning pet over to the nearest humane society or animal shelter. If such sale shall not secure sufficient funds to pay for all charges incurred under this contract, then Owner shall be liable to Animal Lodge for the difference. All monies realized by Animal Lodge at such sale, over and above the charges incurred under this contract and the costs of sale, shall be paid by Animal Lodge to Owner.

(6) This contract is subject to the provisions of C.R.S. 12-64-115 (Abandonment of Animals), which reads:

- (1) Any animal placed in the custody of a licensed veterinarian for treatment, boarding, or other care which is unclaimed by its owner or his agent for a period of more than ten days after written notice, by certified mail, return receipt requested, is given to the addressee only at his last known address shall be deemed to be abandoned and may be turned over to the nearest humane society or animal shelter or disposed of as such custodian may deem proper.
- (2) The giving of notice to the owner, or the agent of the owner, of such animal by the licensed veterinarian, as provided in subsection (1) of this section, shall relieve the licensed veterinarian and any custodian to whom such animal may be given of any further liability for disposal. Such procedure by the licensed veterinarian shall not constitute grounds for disciplining procedure under this article.
- (3) For the purpose of this article, the term "abandoned" means to forsake entirely, or to neglect or refuse to provide or perform the legal obligations for care and support of an animal by its owner, or his agent. Such abandonment shall constitute the relinquishment of all rights and claims by the owner to such animal.

(7) This contract contains the entire agreement between the parties. All terms and conditions of this contract shall be binding on the heirs, administrators, personal representatives and assigns of Owner and Animal Lodge.

(8) If any legal action is brought to enforce the provisions of this contract, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees. These fees, which may be set by the court in the same action or in a different action brought for that purpose, are in addition to any other relief to which the prevailing party may be entitled. Owner agrees that venue for any action or proceeding filed under this contract shall be in Denver County, Colorado.

(9) Owner understands and agrees that in the event that any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable for any reason, all other portions of the agreement will remain in full force and effect.

**Cancellation Policy:** Should it occur that you must cancel your booking, please do so as soon as possible. Cancellations that take place within 2 days of drop off date will be charged a non – refundable one night stay

**I have read, understand and agree to all provisions of the above agreement.** I fully intend to pick up my pet on the above specified date. If circumstances change I will notify Animal Lodge of the new pick up date and assume responsibility for any additional charges incurred.
